

Dog Policy at The Plant

We do not discourage those who wish to bring their dogs to work, but it is neither a safe or appropriate place for unsupervised pets. Therefore, we have provided a dog run and ask that dog owners comply with the following policies:

- 1. Please do not bring your dog into the buildings because there are people on project who are highly allergic to animal dander.***
- 2. Please keep your pet on leash when they are not inside the dog run.***
- 3. Please clean up after your pet immediately after deposit.***
- 4. Please make sure your dog is in good health, up-to-date on immunizations, and free of worms and fleas.***
- 5. Please be sensitive to any disruption your pet may cause others by barking, growling or whining and be prepared to take them home if the problem persists.***

The Plant is a busy place which attracts a wide variety of activities, employees and visitors, including, tours, events, meetings, contractors, suppliers, delivery people, customers and tourists. It is home to one chemical plant - Piedmont Biofuels, which deals with methanol and other caustic chemicals on a large scale.

Not all people are comfortable with the sight of dogs running loose. Some people are afraid of dogs. Others are allergic. And most people don't like to step in dog poop. Plant tenants occasionally bring their children to work. There is a playground for their enjoyment which coincidentally is a preferred spot for unsupervised dogs to relieve themselves.

This policy regarding pets is intended to promote a harmonious relationship among pets, pet owners, non-pet-owners, employees and visitors and a peaceful, clean, and safe environment for all. Dog owners who are not willing to comply will be asked to leave their animals at home.
